Take advantage of heat pump rebates offered by the Sponsors of Energize ConnecticutSM. To qualify, equipment must be installed by a contractor participating in the Energize CT Heat Pump Installer Network and must replace oil, propane, natural gas or electric resistance (baseboard) as the primary heating system. Heat pump rebates are based on equipment capacity (tonnage). See Terms & Conditions for full requirements.
